

AIP Work Clearance Programme

You may be aware, a strategic review of AIP's activities, including AIP Training and Accreditation Programmes, was undertaken in 2006. As a result, AIP has determined that a number of programmes, including the Work Clearance Programme, are no longer relevant to the objectives of AIP.

However, AIP member companies remain committed to the objectives and principles of the Work Clearance programme, and so are assessing the optimal way that the programme, or a suitable alternative, can continue to be available. Importantly, until new arrangements are finalized, Work Clearance programme operation and administration will continue in its current form unless otherwise advised in writing by AIP.

Therefore, to obtain or maintain your company's status as a Work Clearance trained contractor, a representative of your company must attend a training or retraining programme presented by AIP's current training provider.

All Work Clearance contractors will be notified in writing by AIP well in advance of any changes to programme arrangements. We also recommend you regularly check any AIP programme updates on the AIP website during this transition process.
